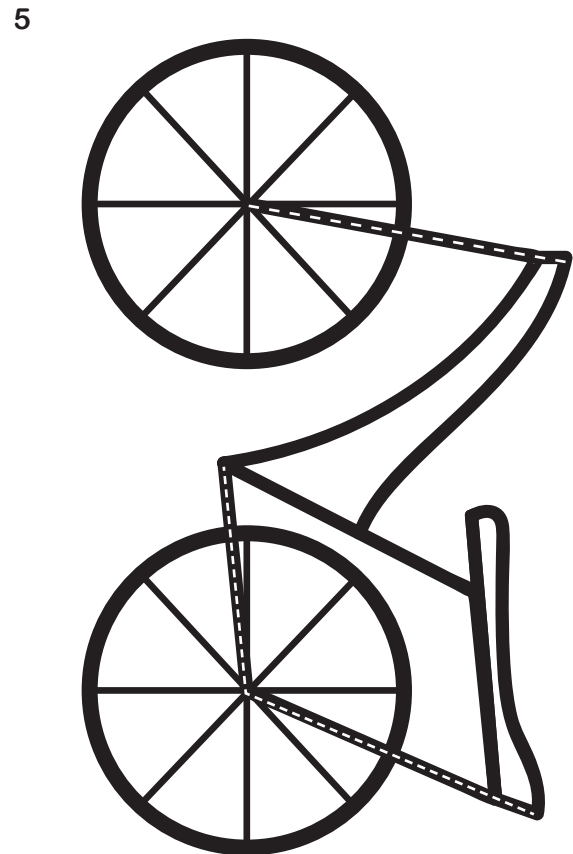
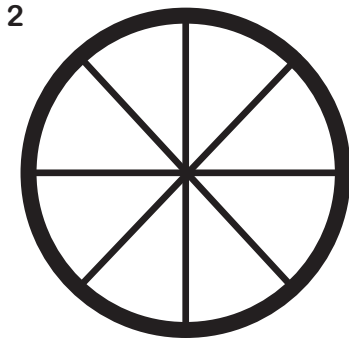
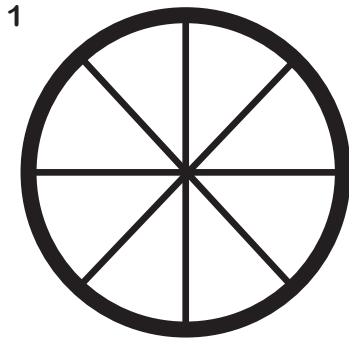

3DOODLER CRAFT TUTORIAL



Have a 3Doodler pen? Grab your supplies and make a cute little bike! Pick whatever colors you like, and if you want to add something cool to your bike, it is highly encouraged. Want to add a kitten for the basket, or maybe some rockets for sick stunts? Or maybe that sounds too crazy and you just came here to make a bike... Don't worry. No matter what you decide, just have fun!



Step one:

Using clear, gray or another plastic of your choosing, trace the spokes and handle bars (1 and 2).

Step two:

Once you know what color you want your bike frame to be, trace the beginning frame labeled piece 4.

Step three:

Using black or another color, outline the spokes to make tires, create grips for the handle bars and widen the seat of the bike.

Step four:

Using drawing 5, place your wheels and the frame down, and attach them by drawing the dashed lines. Flip the bike and repeat the process.



Step five (optional):

Banana seat bikes typically have a raised bar behind them as seen in drawing 6.

Draw two spokes pointing up at the end of the seat, then connect the two. If confused, check out drawing number 11.

Step six:

Attach the handle bars to the bike.

Step seven:

Want a basket? Start by drawing these lines in drawing 7, then create a trapezoid shape as seen in drawing 8.

Once the top is made, create four segments as seen in drawing 9, and connect them to create the bottom. You can now fill in the basket!

Step eight:

While holding the bike at a slight angle, create a small kickstand so it can stand on its own. The kickstand can be seen in drawing 11.

Now you should have a completed bike! Enjoy it, or add to it. Make it yours- just don't eat it or something.
